1. Love All People: How does your initiative love the vulnerable or cross-cultural neighbor?

Andy Crouch states:

"Seeking the common good in its deepest sense means continually insisting that persons are of infinite worth—worth more than any system, any institution, or any cause. Societies are graded on a curve, with the fate of the most vulnerable given the most weight, because the fate of the most vulnerable tells us whether a society truly values persons as ends or just as means to an end."

2. Embody the Gospel: How does this initiative help your church embody the presence of Christ to Phoenix and the world? What is it about who God is, what God does, and what God cares about that make this initiative significant from a gospel-perspective?

3. Holistic: How does this initiative provide opportunity to love whole people and whole communities? How does this work speak Good News and serve our neighbors?

4. Strategic: In what ways does this initiative meet a strategic need at this time and place? Are we reinventing the wheel or is someone else already meeting this need sufficiently and well?

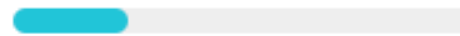

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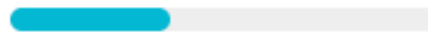
